- D. The City attorney said it would be all right to charge other recreation groups to use the Beach. Motion made to limit buses at the Beach to three (3) a day and that they must have a reservation with the Parks and Recreation office prior to arrival. - E. Mr. Sanford talked about a temporary pass to the beach for someone whose regular vehicle is out of commission for a limited period of time. Motion to institute a temporary Beach pass, there would be no charge for the pass and it would be good for up to five (5) days and it would only be available at the Parks and Recreation department office. F. Mr. Sanford spoke about a \$50.00 cash deposit for use of the Zbierski House to be held until the key was returned and that the House was left clean. (Scott, Harrington 2nd) Passed unanimously.
