If it goes on the ground, it goes in the Sound.

When rain falls it follows paths to all downhill bodies of water. These patterns of flow over land are called **watersheds**. At the mouth of Baker Cove, the Poquonnock River joins with waters of the Baker Cove watershed and enters Fisher's Island Sound, the eastern border of Long Island Sound.

SHELLFISHING KEY

Conditionally Approved RECREATIONAL BEDS
Safe for eating when in open status. Permit required.

Restricted Relay COMMERCIAL BEDS
Not suitable for direct consumption; special license & product cleaning required before eating.

Conditionally Restricted COMMERCIAL BEDS
Not suitable for direct consumption; special license & product cleaning required before eating and may be restricted to certain dates/times.

Prohibited NO COMMERCIAL OR RECREATIONAL SHELLFISHING ALLOWED
Not suitable for direct consumption due to high levels of fecal coliform bacteria / biotoxins causing a public health risk.
