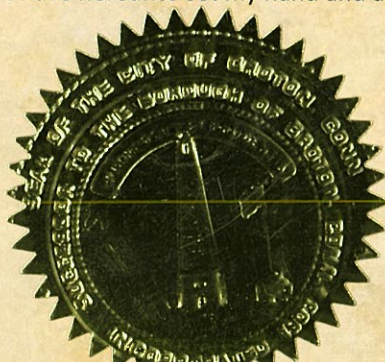
WHEREAS, the City of Groton is proud to honor the history and contributions of African Americans in our community, throughout our state, and nation
