Dear Mooring Customer,

I am writing to inform you of an important change to the process for obtaining and renewing mooring permits with the City of Groton Waters.

Effective immediately, all mooring permit applications and renewals will be handled online through the City of Groton's permitting system called ONLINE MOORING. This new process is designed to improve efficiency, reduce paperwork, and provide customers with a more convenient way to manage their mooring permits.

What this means for you:

- Mooring permit applications and renewals must now be submitted online.
- Required documentation and payments will be completed through the online system.
- Paper applications and in-person submissions will no longer be accepted, except where specifically authorized.

Detailed instructions, including how to access the online system and what information is required will be available on the City of Groton Harbor Management Commission website once the system is launched. We anticipate the online system being launched mid-February. We encourage you to review these instructions carefully before submitting your application to help avoid delays.

Provide a **current and valid email address**, as all future correspondence, notifications, and permit updates will be sent electronically as well as your 2026 intentions to renew your permit.
