Our latest estimate from AECOM is 150 workers for the structural deck (18 mos.) and 300 workers for the building (25 mos.) with little overlap between. We had previously estimated approx. 400 workers. The structural deck work, because of the in water work and significant concrete pours, will likely need to be done in 2-10 hr. shifts 6 days per week. Dredging does not occur until 2024 (after building is completed) and will likely be 24/7 due to the limited window it is allowed (Oct. – May).
