

**141. AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISCONTINUANCE OF DEANE STREET
(INITIALLY APPROVED JUNE 3, 2002; FINALLY APPROVED JULY 1, 2002)**

WHEREAS, Deane Street was laid out by a plan entitled: NELSCO Park, Groton, CT scale 1 inch = 40 ft.; Plan Drawing No. 123 recorded in the Town of Groton Land Records, map book 46, pages 20-21, dated April 24, 1919, shown as Deane Street on said plan; and

WHEREAS, Deane Street is further described as beginning at a point, said point being the northwest corner of Eastern Point Road (SR 349) and then herein described Deane Street intersection; thence running in an easterly direction along said highway line of Deane Street 165.2 meters \pm (542 feet \pm) to a point, said point being the northeast corner of the herein described Deane Street and Mumford Avenue intersection; thence running in a southerly direction along said highway line of Mumford Avenue 16.5 meters \pm (54 feet \pm) to a point, said point being the southeast corner of the herein described Deane Street and Mumford Avenue intersection; thence running in a westerly direction along said highway line of Deane Street 159.4 meters \pm (523 feet \pm) to a point, said point being the southwest corner of the herein described Deane Street and Eastern Point Road (SR 349) intersection; thence running in a northerly direction along said highway line of Eastern Point Road (SR 349) 15.2 meters \pm (50 feet \pm) to the point of beginning. Containing an area equaling 2485.2m² \pm (2671 sf \pm) as shown on a map entitled: "City of Groton, Discontinuance of Deane Street, Deane Street, Groton, Connecticut, Proj. No.: 98840.A50, Date: May 2002, Sheet 1.

WHEREAS, the City of Groton, in connection with a municipal construction project to realign Eastern Point Road is going to discontinue Deane Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Groton Highway and Zoning and Building Departments personnel (a submission to the City of Groton Planning and Zoning Commission in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes §8-24 is being made), the City Attorney, the Mayor and Council have agreed that it is in the best interest of the City of Groton and residents to discontinue Deane Street; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council initially approved "An Ordinance Approving the Discontinuance of Deane Street" at the Mayor and Council meeting held on June 3, 2002; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance was initially published in *The Day*, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Groton, on June 5, 2002 and June 8, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City of Groton Planning and Zoning Commission, the Highway Department and the Department of Utilities of the City of Groton reviewed said plan and proposed easements and are in agreement with the discontinuance of Deane Street;
