

**47. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ACT CONCERNING PENSIONS FOR  
CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GROTON  
(NOVEMBER 17, 1980)**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:**

1. Special Act No. 278 (1945) entitled An Act Concerning Pensions for Certain Employees of the City of Groton, as amended by Special Acts No. 445 (1949) and No. 22 (1955) is hereby amended by adding to Section 7 (Benefits and their payment) the following language:

“The Mayor and Council, upon recommendation from the Retirement Board, may from time to time, increase the pension benefits of retired employees. No such increase shall become effective until the Mayor and Council has received a qualified cost estimate from an actuary, as provided in Section 7-450 of the Connecticut General Statutes, and shall have held a public hearing on the proposed increase.”

Statement of Purpose – to enable retired employees to receive additional pension benefits designed to assist them in meeting increased costs of living.
