

**48. AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING THE USE OF GLASS-CONTAINED BEVERAGES  
AND/OR KEG BEER IN WASHINGTON PARK  
(OCTOBER 1, 1979)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Groton, that the use of glass-contained beverages and/or keg beer in Washington Park is forbidden. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both.

**48. AMENDMENT OF CITY OF GROTON ORDINANCE APPROVED  
OCTOBER 1, 1979 FORBIDDING THE USE OF GLASS-CONTAINED  
BEVERAGES AND/OR KEG BEER IN WASHINGTON PARK  
(NOVEMBER 2, 1981)**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON**, at a regular meeting thereof held on October 5, 1981:

The ORDINANCE FORBIDDING THE USE OF GLASS-CONTAINED BEVERAGES AND/OR KEG BEER IN WASHINGTON PARK is hereby amended to read:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON**, that the use of glass-contained beverages and/or keg beer in Washington Park is forbidden, provided that this Ordinance shall not apply to keg beer consumed at public celebrations, supervised by specific persons, if the City Council has by resolution approved such temporary use under the supervision of those specific persons. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both.
