

**49. ORDINANCE FOR ACCEPTANCE OF INDIAN AVENUE  
(JANUARY 4, 1982)**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:**

**WHEREAS**, Indian Avenue as described on the map entitled “City of Groton, Connecticut, Plan of Indian Avenue, for the purpose of acceptance and improvement, July 27, 1972, Scale 1”=20’, Felix Prokop, Jr., L. S. 8709.” has been offered to the City for acceptance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Public Works has inspected said Indian Avenue and found it to be acceptable in accordance with the road standards of the City of Groton; and

**WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 13(a) of the Charter of the City of Groton empowers the Mayor and Council to accept streets by ordinance;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Groton that the following described tract of land be accepted as a public street and that said street be named Indian Avenue:

Beginning at a mere stone marking the intersection of the East line of Mitchell Street and the North line of Indian Avenue so called,

Thence running S 71 degrees – 33’ E, 305.00 feet to lands belonging to the City of Groton, bounded Northerly by lands of George M. Card, lands of George M. and Daphne R. Card, and lands of Joan P. Robinson.

Thence running S 20 degrees – 00’ W, 50.02 feet to lands belonging to Nicholas Palmerone, bounded Easterly by said City of Groton.

Thence running N 71 degrees – 33’ W, 301.22 feet to the East line of Mitchell Street, bounded Southerly by lands of said Palmerone, land of Edward Pearson, lands of Willie M. and Josie B. Mayo, lands of Norman R. and Norma L. Laboue, and lands of Marlene E. Donovan.

Thence running N 15 degrees – 40’ E 50.06 feet by and along the East line of Mitchell Street to the place of beginning.

Said Indian Avenue to be 50 feet in width.
