

29. AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO THE MANUFACTURE AND TREATMENT OF OIL AND GARBAGE (INITIAL JUNE 4, 1934; FINAL MARCH 25, 1935)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

Section 1 – No person, firm or corporation shall, within the borough of Groton, engage in the business of manufacturing from fish or garbage any oil, guano, fertilizer or phosphate, or in the business of rendering or treating garbage or other filthy or noxious matter. This section shall not apply to the treatment and disposal within such borough of garbage or other filthy or noxious matter originating in said city.

Section 2 – Every person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not more than one hundred dollars or imprisoned not more than thirty days or both.
