

**18. AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DAMAGING AND DEFACING PROPERTY  
(MAY 26, 1904)**

Every person who shall at any time wantonly injure or deface any public or private building or any enclosure of the same, or remove, injure, deface or destroy any fence, railing, post, gate, street lamp, tree, shrub, or vines, or any fruit or produce of any yard, lot or garden, or any other property, public or private, within said city, or shall wantonly bedaub or besmear any building, bridge, water tank, fence, post, sidewalk, premises or vehicle in said city with paint or any filthy substances whatever, or shall commit any nuisance of any kind in or upon the same, or draw, or mark any indecent, obscene or filthy figures or pictures, or write any indecent or obscene words thereon, shall upon conviction of each and every offense forfeit and pay a fine or penalty not to exceed the sum of twenty-five dollars.
