

**19. AN ORDINANCE REGULATING USE OF BICYCLES  
(MAY 26, 1904)**

No person shall ride or propel any bicycle upon any sidewalk within the corporate limits, or shall ride or propel any bicycle within said corporate limits at a greater rate of speed than ten miles per hour or shall between sundown and sunrise, ride or propel any bicycle within said corporate limits without carrying on said bicycle and keeping it lighted, a white light or lantern, and every person riding or propelling a bicycle shall at all times before crossing crosswalks, within said corporate limits, blow a whistle or ring a bell, and shall not cross said crosswalks at a greater rate of speed than five miles per hour. Any person who shall violate any provision of this by-law shall pay a fine not to exceed five dollars, nor less than one dollar.
