

**14. AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISORDERLY CONDUCT
(MAY 26, 1904)**

Any person who may be guilty of shouting, running, shuffling, or other disorderly conduct in or about any railway station, public building, or grounds thereof, or in or about the post office, or who shall disturb the peace or quiet of any of the citizens present at any meeting, concert, exhibition or entertainment, by shouting, whistling, or other disorderly conduct, shall be fined not less than one dollar, nor more than ten dollars and all officers of the city may summarily arrest and confine such offenders.
