

## AMENDED DECEMBER 1, 2014

### 6. A BY-LAW RESTRICTING THE PLACING AND VARIOUS MATERIALS AND ARTICLES IN STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

(MAY 26, 1904)

(AMENDMENT INITIALLY APPROVED NOVEMBER 3, 2014; FINALLY APPROVED DECEMBER 1, 2014)

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance #6 is being amended to be applicable for necessary enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, make the appropriate changes as reflected below:

No person without a permit from the mayor shall place, keep or knowingly suffer to remain, any box, bale, bundle, package, goods, ware, merchandise, cart, carriage, vehicle, lumber, refuse matter, rubbish, earth or stones, or any article, material, or thing of any kind or description, upon any street, sidewalk, public place or upon any City property in said city so as to obstruct or interfere with public travel, create a safety hazard or cause inconvenience or nuisance to the public. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this section shall pay a fine of one hundred dollars.

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance was published in The Day, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Groton on November 6, 2014 and November 7, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the amendments to this Ordinance shall be effective upon passage;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council Finally Approve an Amendment to Ordinance #6 "A By-Law restricting the placing of Various Materials and Articles in Streets and Sidewalks".
